Grading Day

Grading day is held for all junior players in February each year, with the dates and times to be advised closer to the day via our website and Facebook page. The grading day is a compulsory day for all junior players to attend, ensuring the club is able to place each player in the appropriate team for their age group and playing ability. Grading of each player will be based on their performance during the grading day, along with past coaching feedback and grading committee observations made throughout the previous netball season. All players should ensure they are wearing the appropriate footwear and have a bottle of water. If players are unable to make this day please inform the secretary Kirsty Melfi, via email sufnc@outlook.com as soon as possible.

The grading day will also be the last time our uniforms will be available to try on and order before the beginning of the season. Times for when these will be available will also be advised closer to the date.

Friendship Requests

- All players 9 years and above who wish to play in the Junior competition <u>must</u> attend grading day. Players will have the option to submit 1 friendship request to the club via email sufnc@outlook.com. Friendship requests are NOT guaranteed.
- A friendship request MUST be received from both players parents/guardians or will be deemed ineligible. Please do not submit multiple friendship requests, as all requests after the first will be disregarded.
- Cut off for friendship requests is the Thursday BEFORE grading day ie...if grading day is Saturday 11th February, friendship requests MUST be received by Thursday 9th Feb @ 5pm

By submitting this request, I understand that:

- St Ursulas Fatima Netball Club may grade my child into a lower division because of this request
- St Ursulas Fatima Netball Club may grade my child into a different age group because of this request
- St Ursulas Fatima Netball Club Grading decisions are FINAL
- This request will NOT be accepted if registration is closed
- This request will NOT be accepted unless all players requesting to play together submit requests individually

• This request will NOT be accepted if any players requesting to play together are previous development or representative players for St George District Netball Association or any other Netball Association in NSW

- This request will NOT be accepted if any players above are a 'no-show' on grading day held in February
- This request is NOT a guarantee that the players will be placed in the same team

• This request may NOT be accepted if players are born in different years, as overall numbers of the club must be taken into account first

Team Lists

Team lists will be released within two weeks after the grading day, and will be published on both our club website and Facebook page. Once team lists have been announced, no changes will be made.

We ask that you respect the decision made by the grading committee. Many hours of deliberation and consideration are put into each player placement and each is designed to ensure it has a successful season and one in which they can develop their skills in.
